On the way to Rome, notice the panoramic view before taking a quick stop to admire Saint Peter's Square. Then, you will be driven along the Tiber to see the Castle of Angels (originally the tomb of the Emperor Hadrian), the Bridge of Angels and the Palace of Justice. Pass below the Capitol Hill, the smallest and most important of the seven hills of Rome, with the splendid staircase ascending the hill, designed by Michelangelo. Around the bend, exploding before your gaze, you will find the Monument dedicated to Victor Emanuele II, the first king of Italy after its unification. Driving along the Via dei Fori Imperiali, with the ancient Roman Forum on the right and the forum of the Emperor Trajan on the left, you will approach the Colosseum, "a noble wreck in ruinous perfection". Built between 72 AD and 80 AD, it was destroyed by Barbarians and two major earthquakes. From this point, you will see the Arc of the Emperor Constantine and the Palatine Hill. The drive continues to the Circus Maximus, down past the Pagan temples of Hercules and Portus, past the Theatre of Marcellus and on to The Spanish Steps. After this get ready to stretch those legs! Throw a coin in the Trevi Fountain, marvel at the dimensions of the Pantheon and finally stop for a snack at a cafe in Piazza Navona while viewing the fountain of the Four Rivers, designed by Bernini.

One of the most spectacular areas of the villa is the Canopus, a dining hall overlooking a large canal, which could accommodate hundreds of guests invited to Hadrian's magnificent banquets. A Visit to the Teatro Marittimo: Hadrian's headquarters and private retreat surrounded by a moat, it could be completely isolated by simply removing two wooden bridges. Following lunch at a pleasant local restaurant (optional & not included in the price of this shore excursion), we'll visit the enchanting gardens of the Villa D'Este. Tivoli was also the brainchild of one man, the powerful and ambitious Cardinal Ippolito D'este who during the 1500's set out to transform an old Benedictine convent into a new garden of Eden with more than 200 fountains laid out on sloping terraces along with beautiful gardens. Villa D'Este is perfect for a tour in the hot summertime, enjoy the coolness of waterfalls and sit in the shade of mighty ancient cypresses.

Florence and the Leaning Tower of Pisa

10 Hours

Florence is known all over the world as the city of art, the capital of the Renaissance and one of the most important centres of literary and scientific culture. Your first stop will be Piazzale Michelangelo, a wide terrace from where it is possible to admire one of the most superb views of the city nestled in the Arno valley and surrounded by gently sloping hills. In the centre of the square stands the Monument to Michelangelo (1875) with a bronze reproduction of the four statues depicting Day, Night, Dawn and Dusk, dominated by the statue of David. You will then continue by coach into town and have the opportunity to explore the **Galleria dell Accademia** (entry not included in rate), which houses the masterpiece of Michelangelo: David. Next, visit the Ponte Vecchio, the oldest bridge which crosses the Arno at its widest point. This bridge dates back to Roman times and has often been re-built. After a short break for lunch, (optional & not included in the price of this shore excursion) a stop will be made in the Square of Santa Croce (Holy Cross), one of Florence's largest squares, and traditionally one of the city's main arenas for ceremonies and festivities. Visit the **leaning tower of Pisa** before returning to your cruise ship.

Its soaring skyline is its pride, dominated by the gothic Cathedral (Duomo) and the taut needle of the Torre del Mangia, and yet the shell shaped Piazza del Campo, probably captures the most attention and fame. It has been seen in films, photographs and advertising campaigns. The bricks of the Piazza cover the sweetly sloping land, witness to many events in history, but the most intriguing is the Palio horserace, one of the most important things in the life of a Siena native. After the tour you will have some free time for shopping, browsing around and lunch in one of the many open air cafes and restaurants of the Piazza del Campo. You will then board the coach to reach San Gimignano. Here, you will have free time to explore on your own the town of many medieval towers.. San Gimignano, the town of beautiful medieval towers, lies in a picturesque position on a hill dominating the Val d'Elsa, inhabited since the times of the Etruscans.

A 30 minute drive from Livorno in the heart of one of Italy's richest agricultural regions will take you to Lucca. This city is one of Tuscany's best kept secret. The picturesque fortress town is steeped in history; it was here that Caesar, Pompeii and Crassus agreed to rule Rome as a triumvirate in 56 B.C. Later Lucca was the first town that accepted Christianity. In the middle ages the city fell to Florence and during the French invasion Napoleon made Lucca a Municipality and gave it to his sister Elisa whose name is still connected with a number of buildings and sites. After, continue to Pisa, the city of leaning Tower. The leaning tower was originally designed as a bell to the Cathedral. It was begun in 1174 and finally finished in 1350. Unless modern engineering can halt it's tilt it is leaning 5 meters out of it's perpendicular, experts speculate that the structure will collapse in the next 2 centuries.

You will be met at the pier and be taken into the centre of Genoa, the capital of Liguria, which stretches along the bay. The original nucleus of the city already existed in pre-Roman times, but the town developed in the 9th century, when the Genoese built the first town walls and laid the foundations for the development of shipping and sea-trading which would eventually make the Republic of Genoa a Mediterranean sea power. Today the old town district is one of the largest in Europe. Walking closer to Porta Soprana, a medieval gate built from stone and marble between 1155 and 1157, passengers can discover the building said to be the house where the great seafarer Christopher Columbus spent his youth. Continue your tour in the afternoon by visiting Via Garibaldi, one of the most monumental streets in Italy, with the Palazzo della Meridiana and the town hall called the Palazzo Doria Tursi. You will have the chance of admiring the Palazzo Rosso Museum (Civic Gallery of the Red Palace) which houses works by the major Genoese painters, as well as Van Dyck, Titian and Veronese in a XVII century palace. Before driving back to the port, you will be given a panoramic tour of Genoa's seafront suburbs.

Explore the most beautiful stretch of Italian coastline: the Cinqueterre. "Cinqueterre" still today stands for the 5 fishing villages known all over the world for their beauty and charm. The inhabitants of these places had agricultural origins and lived on the hills. They came down and settled down along the coast only when the Saracens stopped threatening their land and homes and when the sea became safe. Only then people started inhabiting the villages at the mouth of the rivers along the shore. Cinqueterre landscape is harsh and wild and even the coast reflects its nature. High cliffs dropping down into the cobalt blue depths of the sea, hiding little beaches at Riomaggiore and Vernazza, or tiny ports like at Manarola. Cinque terre is a UNESCO "World Heritage" area. Enjoy a lunch break in one of the pretty restaurants and bars facing the port before boarding a ferry to Monterosso. This is the furthest west of the five towns and is lined with vineyards and olive groves. You'll find plenty of cliffs and clear water here. Maybe it has the least charm of all the Cinque Terre, but it is the more accessible by car than the others!

The next stop will be the famous resort Sorrento. Learn about the excavation technique of pouring liquid plaster into the empty spaces to determine what the residents were doing at the time of the eruption and you'll gain an insight into the lives of ancient Romans as you discover baths, heaters, temples and markets. The pathways are endless and the buildings fascinating. Some of the recovered houses still contain the original marble decoration, well preserved frescoes and splendid mosaics. After the visit, return to the pier.

Here you will visit the imposing Norman Duomo, one of the greatest architectural masterpieces of the Italian Middle Ages. After departing the Duomo head south to Palermo where you will have time to visit Piazza Dei 4 Canti that divides the city into 4 quarters Each corner is represented with a season, a Patron Saint and a king of Sicily.

Continue through the oldest area of Sicily where open air markets are held and the best fish can be bought, souvenirs and cloth.

If time permits visit the Convent of the Capuccini. In here 8000 bodies of monks are preserved in the basements of the monastery.

This area has been influenced by Arabs and Phoenician culture rather than Greek and Norman of other parts of Sicily. Driving to Segesta, you will pass the tuna fishing village Scopello and resort San Vito Lo Capo, located in the big nature reserve called Zingaro.

Arrive in Segesta, set in the vegetation covering one of the many heights south west of Palermo, the mass of splendid temple rises as one of the most important and best preserved monuments to have survived from antiquity to present day dating back to 430 BC.

Continue to Marsala famous around the world for the salt production and dessert wine that carries the towns name. Invention of a noble Englishman in 1770, he realized that this wine could travel long without going off if fortified with alcohol. After a wine tasting you will stroll through the ancient village visiting the area where Garibaldi, unifier of Italy landed.

Proceed to the walled mountain town of Erice 800 m above sea level. Settled by the Elymians and retained an important religious site associated with Goddess of fertility. From this incredible medieval village it is possible to enjoy the view of the bay of Trapani, marble quarries and salt makers.

Erice is a small town with a population of a few hundred that multiplies during summer periods. Driving back to Palermo visit the Gulf of Castellamare.
